FLOOD RELIEF ACTIVITIES- 2018-19

The NSS Unit of Sree Narayana College Kollam actively devote their times during and after the flood affected in Kerala .College Principal Dr. C Anitha Sankar and NSS Dr. S Vishnu and Smt. Jissa.s coordinate the flood relief programme officers programmes initiated by the NSS Unit. During the days of flood the programme officers and Volunteers collected the necessary articles that are required by the relief camps. During that time NSS office of the SN College Kollam Was a Collection Centre. The NSS Unit could give two mini lorries, necessary articles to the Collectorate and sent the necessary articles to the relief camps in kollam Districts, Alapuzha District, Kottayam District. During the Flood Days the NSS Pathanamthitta District and programme officers and Volunteers came to college in the morning and volunteers were divided into different groups then the programme officers assigned specified areas to each group. After that the Programme officers and volunteers went to the specified flood affected areas assigned to them with the consent of the principal. Some of the volunteers stayed in the camps over nights for the relieving activities.

After the flood the NSS Unit S N College Kollam initiated Number of Flood relieving rehabilitation activates for making new kerala. The NSS programme officers and Volunteers did two days relief and rehabilitation work in the flood affected areas of Chenganur The programme was coordinated by the Kerala university NSS Programme coordinator Dr. Shaji A. The volunteers of the unit supply the guide lines to victims of the flood in different camps in association with Suchithwa Mission. The NSS Programme officers, Principal of the college and one big bus volunteers conducted two times relief and habitation activities in flood affected areas in

Alapuzha and upper part of kuttanad More over The NSS Programme officers, Principal of the college and one big bus volunteers conducted rehabitation and relief activities in St Alosysius College Edathua. The NSS Volunteers, College Principal, NSS Programme officers and teachers cleaned the Class rooms, computer lab, Library hall, Garden etc. The Unit also conducted relief and habitation activities in the flood affected areas of the Kollam District. The Volunteers from our unit actively participated the Swachh Vidyalaya programme. It was jointly organised by the southern Railway Trivandrunm Division, National Service scheme university of Kerala and Kerala public education department.

The details of the flood relief activities conducted by the NSS Unit are:

During the time of flood

1. Collection and Distribution of Necessary Articles

Volunteers and programme officers collect the necessary items to the relief camps from the nearby localities of the college and the NSS office of the unit act as a collection Centre for the purpose. The Unit also made Advertisements campaign through the social medias to collect the articles. More over Principal, Nss programme officers and Volunteers contribute Rs.40, 000 to purchase necessary articles to the relief camps.

2. Distribution of necessary article to the relief camp

The volunteers and programme officers actively engaged to distribute the articles collected in the NSS Unit.

3. Frequent Camp relief camp visit

The volunteers and programme officers frequently visited the number of relief camps to distribute the articles and gave mental and physical helps to the victims of the flood.

4. NSS Office as a collection center (Necessary articles to the relief camp)

During and after the flood period NSS of the Unit act as a collection Centre for collecting the necessary items needed to the relief camp.

Post flood activities

1. Flood Relief and Rehabilitation activities in Chengannur (Naavyam

After the flood the NSS Unit S N College Kollam initiated Number of Flood relieving rehabilitation activates for making new kerala. The NSS programme officers and Volunteers actively worked two days relief and rehabilitation work in the flood affected areas of Chenganur The programme was coordinated by the Kerala university NSS Programme coordinator Dr. Shaji A. 34 volunteers from our unit stayed and worked hard. Highest participation of the Naavyam programme wsa from our NSS Unit.

2. Flood Relief and Rehabilitation activities in Alappuzha and Kuttanad

The NSS Programme officers, Principal of the college, teachers and one big bus volunteers conducted two times relief and habitation activities in flood affected areas in Alapuzha and upper part of kuttanad. The bus was arranged by the kollam mayor Adv. V Rajendra babu.

3. Flood Relief and Rehabilitation activities in St. Aloysius College Edathua.

The NSS Programme officers, Principal of the college and one big bus volunteers conducted rehabitation and relief activities in St Alosysius College Edathua and supplied study materials and notebooks to the students of the college. The NSS Volunteers, College Principal, NSS Programme officers and teachers cleaned the Class rooms, computer lab, Library hall, Garden etc.

4. Distribution of guidelines to the victims of the flood.

The volunteers of the NSS unit SN College Kollam supply the guide lines to victims of the flood in different camps in association with Suchithwa Mission.

5. Swachh Vidyalaya programme.

It was a mega cleaning campaign aimed at rehabilitation of flood affected regions of Kerala. It was jointly organisd by the southern Railway Trivandrunm Division, National Service scheme university of Kerala and Kerala public education department. 

HARITHA MISSION PROJECTS

(Production oriented)

Haritha Mission project implemented by the NSS Unit SN College Kollam in Different Phases in the College campus. The cultivation was done by the financial and technical support of the Krishi Bhavan, kollam corporation. The financial assistance from the Rishi Bhavan was Rs.1, 00,000. The project was implemented with the funding of the college also. This helps to create awareness and Agricultural culture to the students and teachers of our college and the general public. The Haritha Mission Project was inaugurated by the Honorable Agricultural Minister Adv.S. Sunilkumar .. Mannual watering was done during the crop. The cultivation practice was focused to produce organic vegetables.

Land preparation:

300 cents of fallow land in the college campus was cleared, tilled by tractors and prepared for the cultivation. After the soil testing at the soil testing laboratory ,soil amendments like lime was added. The fertilization was done using cowdung and chicken manure .Neem seed cake was used to prevent spared of diseases through soil.

Planting of saplings:

After the preparation of the land planting of the saplings was done. In the first phase it was inaugurated by the Honorable kollam mayor Adv. v Rajendrababu .In the second stage inauguration of the Haritha Mission Project was done . It was inaugurated by the Honorable agricultural minister Adv. S Sunilkumar. College Principal Dr c Anitha Sankar Preside the inaugural function. Kollam MLA N Noushad, Mayor Adv. v Rajendrababu, Deputy mayor Vijaya fracies, Agriculure officers R Ramachandran, Shaji. A delivered the felicitation address and Dr S Vishnu, NSS Programme office delivered the Welcome speech.

Maintenance:

Proper care was given to the seeding. Daily monitoring was done by the Programme officers ,principal and the volunteers. All the organic vegetable areas are divided into number og groups and volunteers assigned to each group. Watering f the plants was done twice daily in the morning and evening. Weeding was done whenever necessary. Pseudomonas was sprayed to prevent diseases. Need waste product were used regularly to prevent and destroy pests.

Harvest Festival (Vilaveduppu utsavam):

The official inauguration of the harvest festivel of the organic vegetable farming was done by the kollam MLA N Noushad. Kollam mayor Adv. V Rajendrababu ,Deputy mayor Vjaya fracies, NSDP Board member Preethi Nadeshan,Princial Dr C Anitha Sankar, Agricultural officers ,NSS programme officers and Volunteers participated the harvest festival.

The official inauguration of the harvest festival of the Paddy crop(Karanel krishi) was done by the Adv. V Rajendrababu, Deputy mayor Vjaya fracies, ,Princial Dr C Anitha Sankar, Agricultural officers ,NSS programme officers and Volunteers participated the harvest festival.

Marketing:

The harvest vegetables were tried to sell to teaches, staff and students of the college. There is a marketing stall in the campus every day in the afternoon section. Rest of the products was selling to the Eco Shop. The return from the harvest was used for the implementation of the **Home for Homeless project**

Phases of implementation

1. First phase - Karanel Krishy (Paddy Cultivation)

The karanel krishy was done approximately one acre of land in the college campus. The technical assistance for the cultivation was given by the agriculture office and karmasena workers to the volunteers. The official inauguration was done by the Honarable kollam Mayor Adv.V Rajendra Babu.

2. Second phase - Organic Vegetable Farming

The official organic vegetable Farming was inaugurated by the Honorable Agricultural Minister Adv.S. Sunilkumar .. Mannual watering was done during the crop. The cultivation practice was focused to produce organic vegetables. About 1.5 Acres of college campus land was used for the cultivation.

3. Third phase -Flower garden

The official inauguration of Flower garden was also done by the Honorable Agricultural Minister Adv.S. Sunilkumar. About 25 cents was used for the Flower garden in the college campus.

4. Fourth phase - Ellu Krishi (sesame cultivation)

After the successful completion of the Karanel krishy Ellu krishi was started about one acres of land in the college campus. The official inauguration of the cultivation was done by the college principal Dr. c Anitha Sankar.



3. Palliative care unit





8. Collection and distribution of dress to poor people


The NSS programme officers and volunteers take initiative to collect reusable nonuse dress items from the students and teachers and distribute the deserved poor peoples.

HEALTH IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMMES


1. Blood Donation Camp


Blood Donation camp 2017
























AIDS Day Celebration 2017 December 1




11. Alzheimer's day
